PUBLIC MEETING

The Richland Township Board of Supervisors meeting held at the municipal building on Wednesday, April 7, 2010 was called to order at 8:00 PM. by Chairman, Herbert C. Dankmyer. There were seven people present in the audience. The Officials present were:

Mr. Allen made a motion to approve the minutes from the Supervisors meeting of March 17, 2010. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Dankmyer asked if anyone in the audience wished to speak. No one came forward.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the bills payable in the following amounts: General Fund: \$68,397, TSA #2: \$1,250 and Sewer Capital Reserve: \$6,100. Mr. Allen seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Allen made a motion to adopt an amendment to the Intermunicipal Sewer Service Agreement with the Deer Creek Drainage Basin Authority providing the conditions upon which Richland Township may accept ownership of a sanitary sewer line to be constructed in West Deer Township to service Phases #3, #4 and #5 of the Parkview Estates Plan and a portion of the Bernard Rogel property. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Allen made a motion authorizing the Chairman to execute a lease agreement with the Pine-Richland Baseball Softball Association for the use of the concession stand located at 1049 Van Velsor Drive for the 2010 season. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Kendrick made a motion authorizing the Chairman to execute a three year contract with Zambelli Internationale for fireworks display at the annual Community Day celebrations: 2010-2012 for the fixed prices of \$11,500, \$12,000 and \$12,500 respectively. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Marshall made a motion authorizing the Township to enter into a service contract with the Eldorado Band to be the featured performer at the Community Day celebration on August 14, 2010. The terms of the contract are subject to approval by the Township Solicitor. Mr. Allen seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Miller asked if it would be possible to control the decibel levels when the warm-up bands are performing. He said the sound is really loud at that point, and people who are congregating find it very difficult to hear each other talk. Mr. Bastianini said that a different audio system will be used this year and that efforts would be made to improve the sound distribution and quality.

Mr. Bastianini presented a proposal from Skuta Signs for a “Welcome to Richland” sign exactly like the one in front of the Richland Mall. The sign could be placed along Route 8 near the northern boundary line. The Supervisors tabled consideration of the proposal and asked that the matter be placed on the agenda of the next meeting.

COMMENTS FROM THE BOARD

Mr. Kendrick made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 4 of 2010 rescinding the Township Traffic Calming Policy as expressed in Resolution No. 23 of 2005. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR

Ms. Annette Robinson, 108 Applewood Drive asked: What the benefit of rescinding the resolution was? Both Mr. Dankmyer and Mr. Bastianini responded to her question.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
